trump food safety.

Right now, USDA inspectors examine 35
chickens per minute to make sure they're
safe to eat. But budget cuts could shift
this process into hyperdrive. Unless
something is done, federal inspectors will
have to examine up to 175 chickens per
minute. **That's nearly three chickens every
second** - more than humanly possible.
